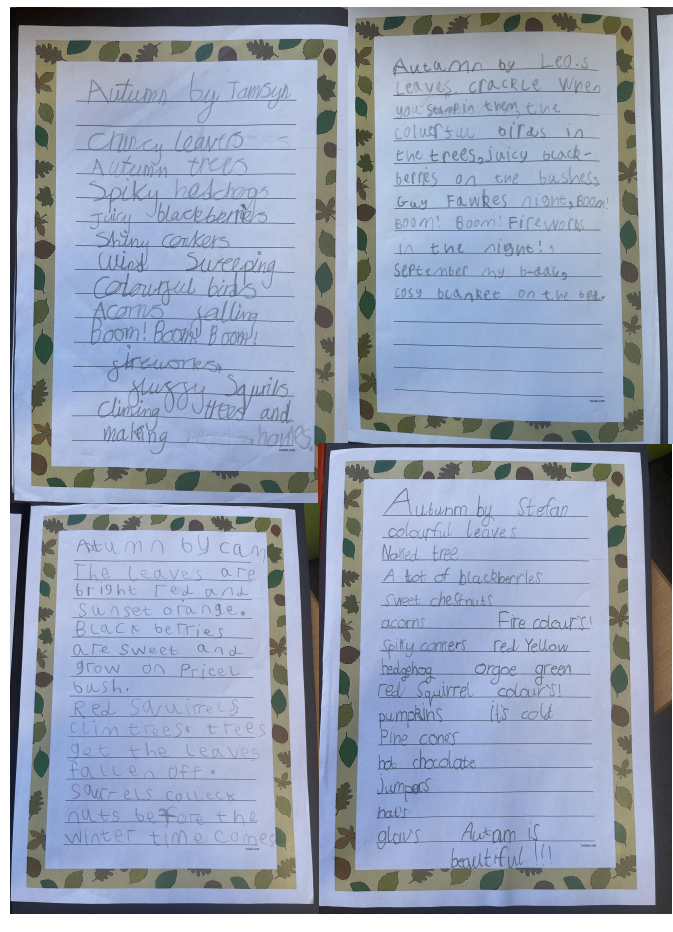


Children in Reception this week have started learning about Piet Mondrian. Over the next few weeks, they will make more artwork inspired by the artist.
