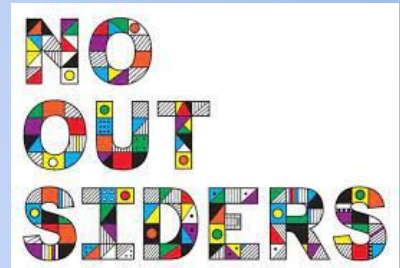
#### Reflection on the week
