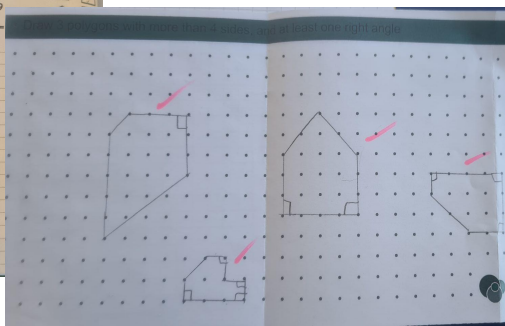
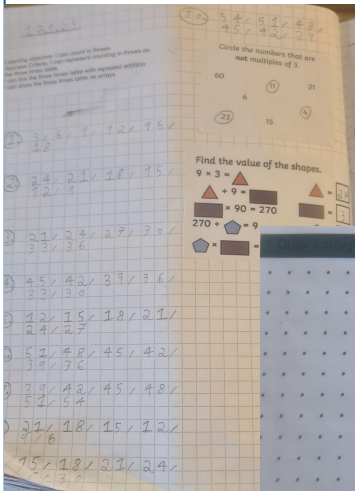
Tower of London Trip
