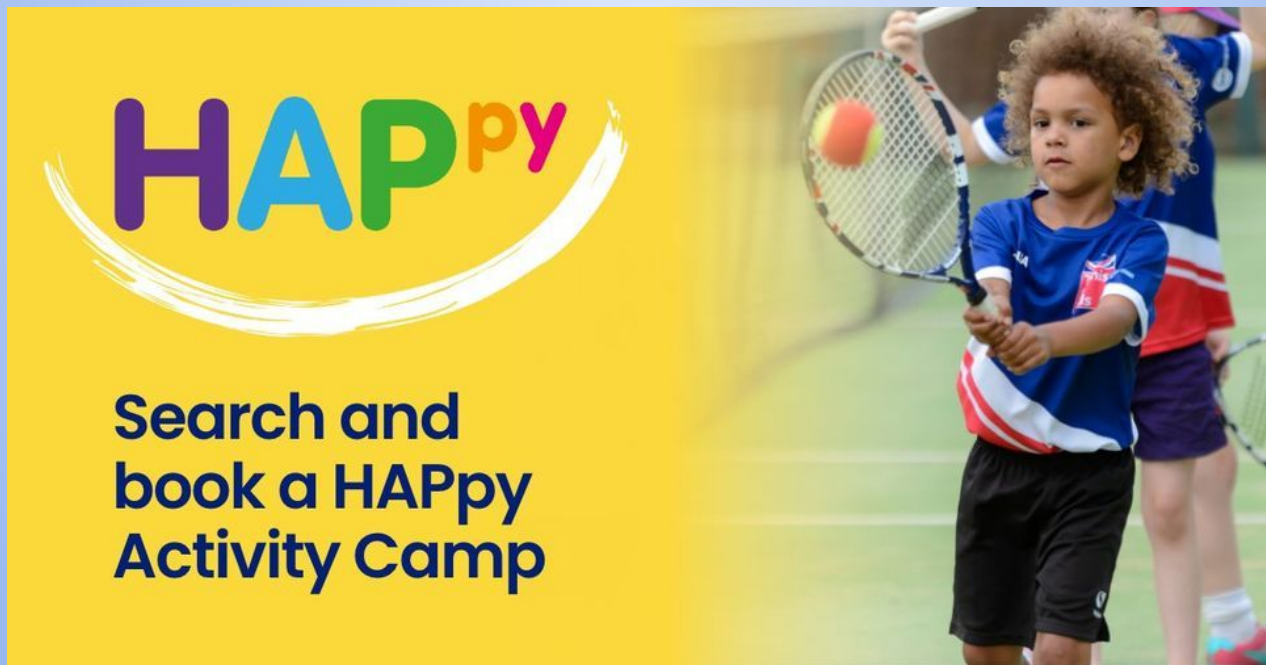

Some camps are specifically for children and young people with SEND. Please contact our school office if you think your child is eligible and you haven't had your code yet.


